Combined Test (CT) Entry: P/T/N/BN/BN-Easy: \$60 (see section 1). Stabling: \$20.00 per night or \$35.00 for weekend outdoor pens; or \$100 covered/indoor stall (see section 5)

**1) ENTRIES:** Entry fees include a \$25 non-refundable office fee. Note: USEA and USEF fees are not included as part of the entry fee; these fees should be added to your entry fee, per the itemized Fees Enclosed section of the Entry Form, totaled with the other applicable fees, and sent to the event with your entry. Use the 2009 Horse Trials Entry and Stabling Forms, and all out-of-state horses: include a copy of negative Coggins within the last 12 months. Health Certificate required for all out-of-state horses: bring with you. In the event of a Vesicular Stomatitis outbreak, Health Certificates must include a VS statement, and may be required for in-state horses also. All attachments must be included with entry. Failure to do so could result in denial of the entry. Incomplete entries will be returned. Double entries: Not accepted. Changes: \$30 per horse/rider per division after C.D., space permitting. Other requirements: All Preliminary riders must be a USEF member or pay a USEF \$30 nonmember fee. Preliminary competitors include copies of the USEF card with entry. All competitors must be USEA members; however, BN competitors may pay \$25 non-member fee. State birth date on entry. \$5 charge for lost pinny. Management reserves right to combine, split, or cancel classes; cancel or add judges as entries warrant, and refuse any entries. Refunds: Before C.D.-Less \$25 non-refundable office fee & organization fees; After C.D.-Entry at discretion of organizing committee with vet/physician certificate. Competition cancellation-No refund.

**1) ENTRIES:** Be sure to designate "Championship" on entry. Entry fees include \$25 non-refundable office fee. Checks and credit card charges will be processed upon entry acceptance. If undersubscribed the close date will be extended and a \$25 late fee will be assessed. Double entries: Not accepted. YOUNG HORSE Entries - All horses in these classes must be registered with USEA and their breed association. Please use separate 2009 YEH Entry form for these classes All Intermediate & Preliminary riders must include copy of USEF member card for rider and owner w/ entry. USEA and USEF fees are not included as part of the entry fee. Add these association fees to your entry fee, per the itemized Fees Enclosed section of the Entry Form, totaled with other applicable fees and submit with your entry.
